# **AGENDA HEADING:**

Ordering construction of the following: 2017 Sewer Repair - Contract 1 - Receiving bids, (9-12-17), and Setting date of hearing, (9-25-17). Construction Estimate - \$490,000.

# **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the construction of a relief storm sewer along Lower Beaver Road from Valdez Court to Twana Drive and creek stabilization of deteriorated storm sewer infrastructure at Ashby Park and Harmon Park.



#### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2017 Sewer Repair Contract 1, 08-2017-002. The improvement includes the construction of storm sewers, manholes, intakes, gabion basket walls, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement replacement, seeding, surface restoration, and other incidental items; in accordance with contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 585-205/238 at three (3) locations: Lower Beaver Road from Valdez Court to Twana Drive, Ashby Park at 3200 38<sup>th</sup> Street, and Harmon Park at 2900 SW 26<sup>th</sup> Street, all in Des Moines Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$490,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
