AGENDA HEADING:

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend Municipal Housing Governing Board approval for the Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency to reduce the term and release the second mortgage and security instruments for Elfadil Siam (AKA Elfadil Arbab) and Amal Kokola (AKA Amal Kunda).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Elfadil Siam (AKA Elfadil Arbab) and Amal Kokola (AKA Amal Kunda) have successfully completed the program requirements of the Municipal Housing Agency’s 5(h) Affordable Homeownership Program and requirements for the early forgiveness of the term of the second mortgage. They currently have a seven (7) year forgivable second mortgage in the amount of \$33,000 with the Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency. However, since they have lived in the home for more than seven (7) years and have completed program requirements, City Legal has prepared a Release and Satisfaction of the Second Mortgage and staff is requesting authorization to execute and record the document.
