**AGENDA HEADING:**

Approval of submission of a funding application for 11 Section 8 Housing Choice vouchers to the U.S. Department of Housing & Urban Development (HUD).

**SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval to submit to HUD an application for funding for 11 Section 8 Housing Choice vouchers and to authorize the City Manager, or his designee, to execute and implement the funding when awarded.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: Annually \$55,312 housing assistance payments and \$2,200 administrative fee.

Funding Source: S350 HSG125000 – Section 8, page 113

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- The Des Moines Municipal Housing Agency (DMMHA) has previously received funding from HUD to administer the Section 8 Housing Choice Voucher program.
- The current owner of River Hills Apartments #1, located at 700 E. 5<sup>th</sup> Street, Des Moines, Iowa, has opted out of their Section 8 HUD Multifamily Housing Program contract and Section 8 Housing Choice vouchers are being requested for an additional 11 eligible residents at River Hills Apartments #1.
- DMMHA will be awarded 11 Housing Choice vouchers to provide rental assistance to these families.
- The annual funding amount for rental assistance will be approximately \$55,312.
