AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 1401 E. 12th Street Building Demolition - Receiving bids, (10-10-17), and Setting date of hearing, (10-23-17). Demolition Estimate - \$275,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with demolition of the building and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project will remove the former Wallace School, at 1401 E. 12th Street, that has been condemned by the City of Des Moines as per Roll Call No. 15-0344 on February 23, 2015.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the demolition of the 1401 E. 12th Street Building, 25-2018-005. The improvement includes demolition of the former Wallace School, including site clearance, backfill, and disconnection of utilities and plumbing services; all in accordance with the contract documents, located at 1401 E. 12th Street, Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated demolition cost is \$275,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
