AGENDA HEADING:

Approval of extension of 28E Agreement with Neighborhood Development Corporation (NDC) and City of Des Moines.

SYNOPSIS:

Request Council approval of a new 28E Agreement between the City of Des Moines and NDC. This agreement covers the period December 1, 2017 to December 30, 2020 and obligates the City of Des Moines to pay to NDC \$1,000,000 per year.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$1,000,000 annually for three (3) years.

Funding Source: G.O. Bonds, CP051 CMO99 MS003 – Adopted Capital Improvement Program – Miscellaneous Improvements (page 10).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The City of Des Moines has maintained a relationship through 28E Agreements with NDC dating back to 1998 to plan, coordinate and implement public and private redevelopment efforts within Chartered and Designated Neighborhoods. The most recent agreement was for a five (5) year period to end November 30, 2017.
