AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on E. 6th Street and Des Moines Street Traffic Signals. Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer’s estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Van Maanen Electric, Inc., Nathan S. Van Maanen, President, \$181,161.97.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the E. 6th Street and Des Moines Street Traffic Signals and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. The project includes the construction of a new traffic signal, pavement markings, and sidewalk ramps at the intersection of E. 6th Street and Des Moines Street.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On October 9, 2017, under Roll Call No. 17-1710, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the E. 6th Street and Des Moines Street Traffic Signals. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the E. 6th Street and Des Moines Street Traffic Signals, 04-2017-020. The improvement includes the construction of traffic signals, vehicle loop detectors, pavement markings, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalk ramps, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 587-185/199, located at the intersection of E. 6th Street and Des Moines Street, Des Moines, Iowa.

- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - Baker Electric, Inc., Des Moines, IA
 - Van Maanen Electric, Inc., Newton, IA, - Bid read under advisement to determine if bid bond not affected by written amount of bidder
 - Iowa Signal, Inc., Grimes, IA
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the City Engineer in the Shijiazhuang Room, 2nd Floor, City Administration Building, 400 E. Court Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on October 24, 2017.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Van Maanen Electric, Inc., Nathan S. Van Maanen, President, 627 North 19th Avenue, East, PO Box 1131, Newton, IA, 50208 in the amount of \$181,161.97, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
