Court Avenue, Suite 140, Des Moines, Iowa, 50309, for an additional amount not to exceed \$90,139, based on hourly rates, to provide additional design and construction administration services for the Grand Avenue Bridge over the Des Moines River Replacement project.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On January 27, 2014, by Roll Call No. 14-117, the City and Shuck-Britson, Inc. entered into a Professional Services Agreement (PSA), in connection with the Grand Avenue over Des Moines River Bridge Replacement, not to exceed \$626,169.
- On March 7, 2016, by Roll Call No. 16-0371, the City and Shuck-Britson, Inc. entered into Supplemental Agreement No. 1 for additional bridge aesthetic development and final design services, not to exceed \$160,193.
- On August 25, 2016, the City and Shuck-Britson, Inc. entered into Supplemental Agreement No. 2 for additional construction administration services, not to exceed \$14,925.
- Grand Avenue Bridge closed for construction on September 19, 2016. During construction, several design changes were required based on field conditions encountered and to aid in constructability. Both bridge abutments were modified to a semi-integral abutment design, additional piles were added to a pier footing, and supplemental haunch reinforcing was required after verifying as-built beam camber elevations.

• In addition to the design changes, multiple shop drawing submittals were required as part of the final bridge design. Each shop drawing submittal has required multiple review iterations of shop drawings and review information that was not originally anticipated.
