AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with Substance, LLC for design phase and construction phase services for the Columbus Park Shelter Renovation, not to exceed \$58,600.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the PSA with Substance, LLC, Mindy Aust, Principal, 1300 Walnut Street, Suite 201, Des Moines, Iowa 50309, for a lump sum of \$58,100 and reimbursable costs not to exceed \$500, to provide design phase and construction phase services for the Columbus Park Shelter Renovation.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The existing park shelter located at Columbus Park, 1949 Indianola Avenue, was constructed in 1940 to provide changing rooms and support facilities to an adjacent wading pool. When the wading pool was removed, the shelter was converted to public use restrooms and storage space for park equipment. The City proposes to create an enclosed year-round public use shelter space with accessible restrooms and outdoor patio, and to connect the shelter by way of an accessible route to the parking lot and Columbus Park amenities.
- A Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued, posted on the City's website, and printed in the newspaper to provide design and construction phase services for the Columbus Park Shelter Renovation.
- A selection committee of Park and Recreation, Facilities, and Engineering staff reviewed and rated the six (6) proposals received in response to the RFP. Substance, LLC was selected based on their qualifications and the selection criteria in the RFP.

• City staff has negotiated a PSA with Substance, LLC for a lump sum of \$58,100 and reimbursable costs not to exceed \$500, to provide design phase and construction phase services for the Columbus Park Shelter Renovation.
