# AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 31st Street Reconstruction from I-235 to University Avenue: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as MPS Engineers, P.C. dba Kingston Services, P.C., Umesh G.Shetye, President, \$686,171.60.

### SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 31st Street Reconstruction from I-235 to University Avenue and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the reconstruction of 31st Street from I-235 to University Avenue. The project addresses citizen concerns regarding the condition of City streets by improving deteriorating infrastructure.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount:</u> \$686,171.60 Construction Contract (\$880,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2017-2018 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page Street – 30, Roadway Reconstruction, ST260, Being: \$444,641.60 Road Use Tax Funds, \$111,765.00 of Storm Water and \$111,765.00 of Sanitary Sewer Funds, and the remaining \$18,000 from Des Moines Water Works.

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

• On December 4, 2017, under Roll Call No. 17-2038, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 31st Street Reconstruction from I-235 to University Avenue. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 31st Street Reconstruction from I-235 to University Avenue, 06-2017-002. The improvement includes the reconstruction of 31st Street from I-235 to University Avenue with full-depth Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement, including pavement scarification and removal, furnish and place HMA, full depth Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) patching, PCC curb and gutter, PCC sidewalk, PCC driveway, pavement markings, sidewalk ramps, 15-inch and 24-inch RCP storm sewer, intakes, manholes, sanitary sewer repairs, water main alterations, modular block retaining wall, fencing, sodding, and miscellaneous associated work including cleanup; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 588-140/193, located at 31st Street from I-235 to University Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.
