## **AGENDA HEADING:**

Approving and authorizing the execution of the Chapter 28E Agreement by and between the City of Des Moines, Iowa and the Des Moines Wastewater Reclamation Authority (WRA) for a Public Improvement Project Storm Sewer and Sewer Separation Improvements for the WRA Eastside Interceptor, Phase 27, Segment 5.

## **SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend approval of Chapter 28E Agreement between the City of Des Moines, Iowa and WRA for a Public Improvement Project for the WRA Eastside Interceptor, Phase 27, Segment 5, to include storm sewer improvements along E. 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Mattern Avenue, E. 13<sup>th</sup> Street, and Jefferson Avenue necessary to remove storm intakes along Jefferson Avenue at E. 12<sup>th</sup> Street, E. 13<sup>th</sup> Street, and York Street from the combined sewer system.


Amount: \$449,284 (Estimated City cost by the WRA)

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2017-18 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page Sanitary – 9, Lower Oak Park and Highland Park Sewer Separation, SS133, Sanitary Sewer Funds and Storm Water Utility Funds

#### ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The WRA plans to construct the WRA Eastside Interceptor, Phase 27, Segment 5 Project which includes construction along portions of the rights-of-way of E. Jefferson Avenue and York Street.
- As part of the Long Term Control Plan developed to eliminate combined sewer overflows, the City of Des Moines planned as part of a public improvement project titled Lower Oak and Highland Park Sewer Separation Project to construct storm sewer improvements along E. 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Mattern Avenue, E. 13<sup>th</sup> Street, and Jefferson Avenue necessary to remove storm intakes along Jefferson Avenue at E. 12<sup>th</sup> Street, E. 13<sup>th</sup> Street, and York Street from the combined sewer system.
- Due to the proximity of the WRA's construction of the WRA Eastside Interceptor, Phase 27, Segment 5 Project to the City's planned storm sewer improvements along E. 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Mattern Avenue, E. 13<sup>th</sup> Street, and Jefferson Avenue, the parties have agreed it is of mutual benefit to have the WRA complete the design and construction for the City's planned storm sewer improvements

along E. 12<sup>th</sup> Street, Mattern Avenue, E. 13<sup>th</sup> Street, and Jefferson Avenue during the course of the WRA Eastside Interceptor, Phase 27, Segment 5 Project.
