AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 59th and 62nd Streets at Douglas Avenue Traffic Signal Replacements - Receiving bids, (2-20-18), and Setting date of hearing, (3-8-18). (Construction Estimate - \$310,000).

SYNOPSIS:



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 59th and 62nd Streets at Douglas Avenue Traffic Signal Replacements, 04-2017-021. The improvements include the replacement of traffic signals, fiber network, sidewalk ramps, new vehicle loop detectors, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 591-001/022, located at the intersections of 59th Street and Douglas Avenue and 62nd Street and Douglas Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.
- These signals are at the end of their useful life and are being rebuilt as part of Traffic and Transportation's signal replacement program to address aging infrastructure.
- The estimated construction cost is \$310,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
