AGENDA HEADING:

Approving and authorizing the execution of the Agreement for Cooperative Public Service with Polk County for the hot-mix asphalt resurfacing of E. Aurora Avenue and NW Morningstar Drive.

SYNOPSIS:

Approving and authorizing the execution of the Agreement for Cooperative Public Service with Polk County for the hot-mix asphalt resurfacing of:

- E. Aurora Avenue from E. 25th Street to E. Colfax Avenue, and
- NW Morningstar Drive from NW Aurora Avenue to the limits of the recently completed Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) replacement of NW Morningstar Drive Bridge over I-35/80.

Polk County will be the lead agency and will be responsible for the design and construction of the hot-mix asphalt resurfacing project.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$121,760.21 (City Cost Share as estimated by Polk County)


<u>Funding Source</u>: 2017-18 Capital Improvement Program (CIP), Page Street Improvements – 28, Rehabilitation and Preservation of Major Roadways, ST222

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- Polk County, in coordination with the City of Des Moines, has developed a project to resurface:
 - o E. Aurora Avenue from E. 25th Street to E. Colfax Avenue, and
 - NW Morningstar Drive from NW Aurora Avenue to the limits of the recently completed IDOT replacement of NW Morningstar Drive Bridge over I-35/80.
- Portions of these roadways are in the boundary between City Corporate Limits and unincorporated Polk County, requiring the improvements to be developed in a coordinated manner.

- Polk County is the lead agency for this resurfacing project, and will be performing the design and construction management.
- The City and County have prepared an Agreement for Cooperative Public Service which provides a cost share between the County and City based on jurisdictional ownership of the roadway. The total project cost is estimated by Polk County to be \$376,207.82, with the City's cost share being estimated by Polk County to be \$121,760.21.
- The construction of this resurfacing project is scheduled to occur in 2018, targeting completion by mid-November 2018.
