SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval for the Information Technology (IT) Department to purchase computers from Hewlett Packard for replacement of existing computers using State of Iowa contract pricing. The Procurement Administrator has determined that the pricing has been competitively bid and is available to the City via State of Iowa Contract 16055.

Previous council action approved the State of Iowa contract purchase of computers from Hewlett-Packard Company up to a total annual estimated of \$150,000. This additional funding is needed to replace the oldest hardware (desktop and laptop staff computers) to bring equipment up to a regular replacement plan required to keep the City network secure.
