AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Polk Boulevard Reconstruction from Grand Avenue to I-235 - Receiving bids, (3-27-18), and Setting date of hearing, (4-9-18). Construction Estimate - \$850,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This reconstruction project addresses the deteriorated roadway condition of Polk Boulevard from Grand Avenue to I-235 with installation of full-depth Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Polk Boulevard Reconstruction from Grand Avenue to I-235, 06-2018-004. The improvement includes the reconstruction of Polk Boulevard from Grand Avenue to I-235, including pavement removal, excavation, geogrid, subbase, full-depth HMA pavement, pavement markings, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 590-246/255, located on Polk Boulevard from Grand Avenue to I-235, Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$850,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of
 contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's
 Office.
