AGENDA HEADING:

Public hearing for approval of the 2017 U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) Consolidated Annual Performance and Evaluation Report (CAPER).

SYNOPSIS:

Every year, the City must conduct a public hearing to review how federal funds were utilized in its community development programs. The past program year’s outcomes and results are published in the CAPER for public comment. After the public hearing, the CAPER will be submitted to HUD for final review and approval. The CAPER is a compliance requirement for the City to continue to receive federal funds for programs that support affordable housing, economic development, public services, and homelessness.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: HUD allocated \$3,403,924 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), \$733,582 in HOME Investment Partnerships Program (HOME), and \$304,561 in Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) funds in 2017.
