**AGENDA HEADING:**

Ordering construction of the following: 2018 Neighborhood Sidewalk Program - Receiving bids, (4-10-18), and Setting date of hearing, (4-23-18). Construction Estimate - \$302,400.

**SYNOPSIS:**

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the replacement of defective sidewalks under the Step It Up - Infrastructure Improvements Program as identified by the Engineering Department, and for the construction of new sidewalks to connect gaps in existing sidewalk networks near schools and along priority pedestrian routes in neighborhoods throughout the City of Des Moines, Iowa.

Funding Source: Recom. 2018-19 CIP, Page Streets – 35, Sidewalks - School and Priority Routes, SW081, G. O. Bonds

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer’s estimate for the construction of the 2018 Neighborhood Sidewalk Program, 09-2018-005. The following improvements include furnishing labor, equipment, and materials all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 593-172/178, at the following locations all within the City of Des Moines, Iowa:
  - Removal and reconstruction of Class A and Class B Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalks, grading and construction of new PCC sidewalks, and the removal and reconstruction of brick sidewalks. Sidewalks will be replaced and constructed at locations inspected and identified by the City of Des Moines Engineering Department within the Capitol Park Neighborhood as a part of the Step It Up - Infrastructure Improvements Program.

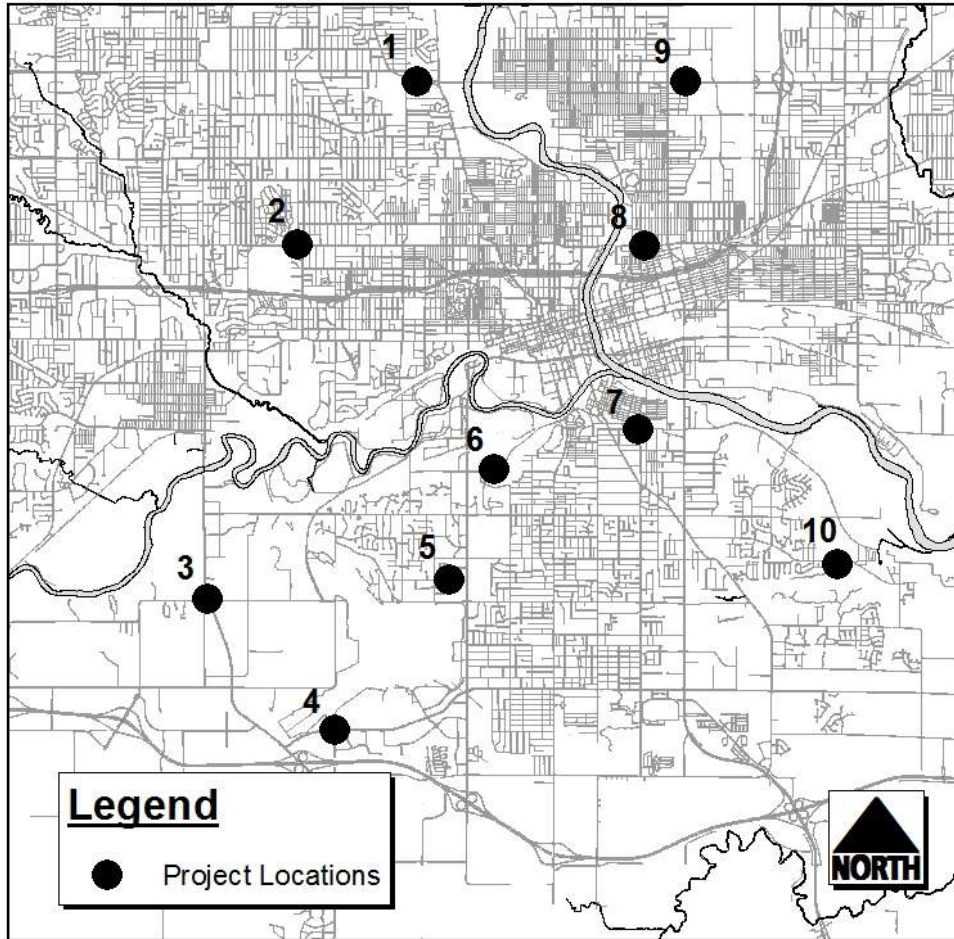
- Grading and construction of new PCC sidewalk near the following locations inspected and identified by the City of Des Moines Engineering Department:

Euclid Avenue from 27th Street to 30th Street  
Stanton Avenue from Fleur Drive to S.W. 26th Street  
1530 E. Euclid Avenue  
S.E. 5th Street and Hartford Avenue  
S.W. 63rd Street and Veterans Parkway  
S.W. 42nd Street and Army Post Road  
Thomas Beck Road and Crown Colony Court  
Easter Lake Trail Connection

- Removal of PCC curb and sidewalk, and construction of PCC doweled median over existing PCC pavement near the following location inspected and identified by the City of Des Moines Engineering Department:

48th Street and University Avenue

- In the vicinity where sidewalks will be constructed, curb ramps compliant with the requirements of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 and the regulations associated with this law as it applies to pedestrian facilities will also be constructed.
- The estimated construction cost is \$302,400. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
