AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with HR Green, Inc. for additional construction phase services for the Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway and Prospect Road Traffic Signals, not to exceed \$22,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the PSA with HR Green, Inc., Steve Heyer, P.E., President/CEO, 5525 Merle Hay Road, Suite 200, Johnston, IA 50131, for an additional amount not to exceed \$22,000, based on hourly rates, to provide construction phase services for Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway and Prospect Road Traffic Signals.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On January 9, 2017, by Roll Call No. 17-0013, City Council approved a PSA with HR Green, Inc. for design services for the Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway and Prospect Road Traffic Signals, not to exceed \$31,000.
- On October 9, 2017, by Roll Call No. 17-1790, the Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway and Prospect Road Traffic Signals was awarded to Iowa Signal, Inc. for \$234,441.35.
- City staff has negotiated Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Agreement for Professional Services with HR Green, Inc., for an additional amount not to exceed \$22,000, to provide for construction phase services.
