**AGENDA HEADING:**

Consideration of removal of existing traffic circles at the intersections of SE 24th Street and E Porter Avenue and SE 24th Street and Hart Avenue.

**SYNOPSIS:**

A request was received from a resident of the Chateaus at Carman Estates to remove the existing traffic circles at SE 24th Street and E Porter Avenue and SE 24th Street at Hart Avenue. If the circles are removed the intersections would stay as 2-way stop control.

**FISCAL IMPACT:**

Amount: \$16,000

Funding Source: Recommended 2018-19 CIP, Page Street - 8, Concrete Paving Restoration Program - Public Works, ST102.

**ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- A request was received from a resident of the Chateaus at Carmen Estates to remove the existing traffic circles at the intersections of SE 24th Street and E Porter Avenue and SE 24th Street and Hart Avenue. An email was sent out by the resident to 42 of the neighbors who live in Carman Estates, mostly from Chateaus at Carman Estates. Of 21 neighbors that responded, 17 wanted the traffic circles removed, two (2) wanted them to stay, and two (2) were undecided. There are approximately 70 properties that front E Porter Avenue and Hart Avenue east of SE 24th Street that could be affected by the removal of these traffic circles.
- If the request is approved, the City will remove the traffic circles and replace with concrete. The intersection would remain a 2-way stop controlled intersection. The removal of the circles and paving would be added to the 2018 City-wide PCC Pavement Restoration Program with the work scheduled to be done by the end of 2018.
