AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2018-2019 Expanded Street Resurfacing Program - Contract 1: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer’s estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Kurt Rasmussen, President, \$1,104,949.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2018-2019 Expanded Street Resurfacing Program - Contract 1 and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for full depth patching, scarification of existing asphalt streets, and Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) overlay of arterial and residential streets Citywide. The project addresses citizen concerns regarding the condition of City streets by preserving deteriorating infrastructure. This project includes pavement markings to convert E. 30th Street from 4-lanes to 3-lanes between Dean Avenue and University Avenue. This project also includes patching and a HMA overlay at the Cownie Soccer parking lot.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$1,104,949 Construction Contract (\$1,500,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

Funding Source: 2018-2019 CIP, Page Street - 41, Special City-wide Street Improvements, ST217, Being: \$1,003,987 in Gaming Monies; \$67,335 in G.O Bonds from PK176, Sports Complexes; and the remaining \$33,627 in G.O. Bonds from ST231, Streetscape Improvements.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On March 19, 2018, under Roll Call No. 18-0433, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2018-2019 Expanded Street Resurfacing Program - Contract 1. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2018-2019 Expanded Street Resurfacing Program - Contract 1, 06-2018-006. The improvement includes scarification of existing asphalt streets, furnish and place HMA, furnish and place pavement markings, traffic signal modifications, and other incidental items; in

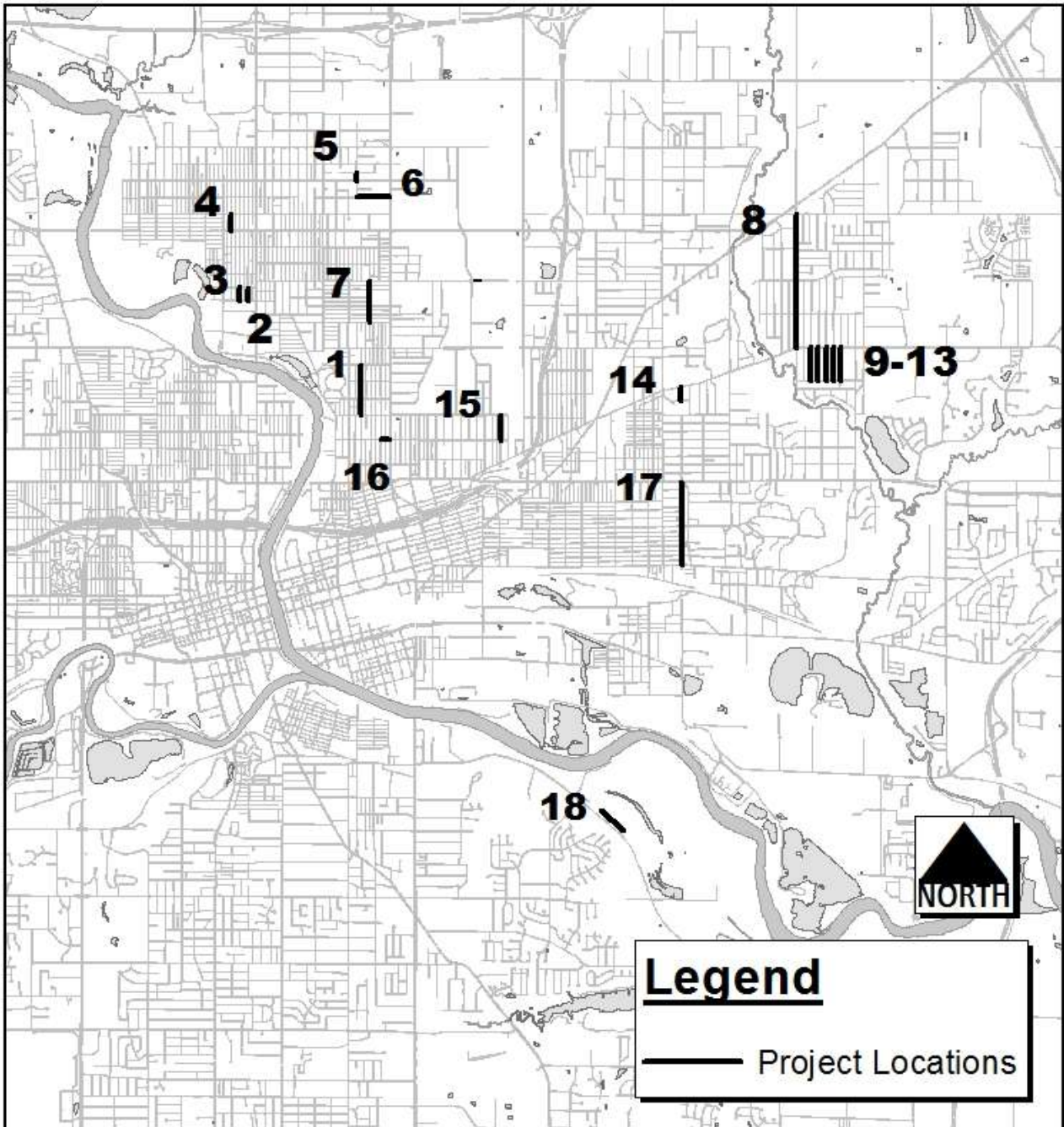

The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
