AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Hubbell Avenue and University Avenue Intersection Improvements - Receiving bids, (5-22-18), and Setting date of hearing, (6-11-18). Construction Estimate - \$187,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. The project includes intersection and traffic signal modifications at the southwest corner of Hubbell Avenue and University Avenue.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Hubbell Avenue and University Avenue Intersection Improvements, 04-2017-015. The improvement includes 10-inch Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement, 10-inch thick curb & gutter, 6-inch PCC median island, 5-inch and 6-inch PCC sidewalk, decorative brick color and patterned PCC, traffic signal modifications, earthwork, modified subbase, scarification, Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) surface, traffic control, other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents including Plan File Nos. 585-057/072, located at the southwest corner of Hubbell Avenue and University Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$187,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.

- This work is necessary to provide a proper radius for turning truck traffic and to move the traffic signal pole outside of the path of turning vehicles. Sidewalk and patterned concrete will be installed along the adjacent property to match existing streetscape elements on the north side.
- The City Council has expressed concerns regarding impacts to adjacent businesses from simultaneous projects, as the WRA Eastside Interceptor, Phase 27, Segment 4 project currently under construction in the same area of said Hubbell Avenue and University Avenue Intersection Improvements project, and may have caused additional adverse impacts to the adjacent businesses. Therefore, on August 23, 2017, by Roll Call No. 17-1438, City Council rejected all bids on Hubbell Avenue and University Avenue Intersection Improvement and City will rebid in the future.
- The WRA Eastside Interceptor Phase 27, Segment 4 is scheduled to be completed before the State Fair in August 2018. The Hubbell Avenue and University Avenue Intersection Improvements are scheduled to start after the State Fair in 2018.
