AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Schedule of Fees regarding construction, temporary, and annual permits issued by the Fire Department.

SYNOPSIS:

Consistent with the recommendations found in the fee study performed in 2010 by Management of America Inc, on behalf of the City of Des Moines, to ensure recovery of costs associated with permit inspections. Approval of this Amended Fee Schedule updates the current Fire Department Fire Prevention Bureau fee structure for permits (construction, temporary, and annual permits). To provide sufficient time to incorporate the new fee structure into the contractor bidding process, the revised fee structure will be effective beginning on September 1, 2018.
