### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Release of restrictive covenants limiting the use of tax abatement in Airport Business Park, Airport Commerce Park South and Airport Crossroads.

#### **SYNOPSIS:**

Office of Economic Development (OED) staff recommend approval of the Resolution releasing the restrictive covenants limiting the use of tax abatement to the 3-year, 100% schedule in Airport Business Park, Airport Commerce Park South and Airport Crossroads. Release of the restrictive covenants will allow new development in these parks to seek tax abatement under any schedule allowed by the Citywide Urban Revitalization Plan.

### FISCAL IMPACT: NONE

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- As part of the negotiated City assistance in development of the Airport Business Park, Airport Commerce Park South, and the Airport Crossroads, the City required covenants that restricted the availability of tax abatement for new developments to the 3-year, 100% schedule.
- The Economic Development Urban Renewal Areas and Tax Increment Financing (TIF) Districts set up to assist in the development of infrastructure (i.e., streets, water and sewer) in these parks have expired and are no longer in effect thereby returning valuations to the City General Fund.
- The covenants restricting tax abatement to the 3-year, 100% schedule are set to expire in the business parks at various dates over the next two (2) to three (3) years.
- To assist in marketing the undeveloped business park lots, and to remain competitive with other business parks in the City, OED staff are recommending that the covenants restricting tax abatement to the 3-year, 100% schedule be released simultaneously for Airport Business Park, Airport Commerce Park South and Airport Crossroads.
- Releasing of the restrictive covenants, will allow new development to seek tax abatement under any schedule allowed by the Citywide Urban Revitalization Plan.
