AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: SW 9th Street Rehabilitation from Wall Avenue to Army Post Road - Receiving bids, (6-26-18), and Setting date of hearing, (7-9-18). Construction Estimate - \$760,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project will improve the existing pavement condition of SW 9th Street between Wall Avenue and Army Post Road by rehabilitating and resurfacing the deteriorated pavement. The project addresses citizen concerns regarding the condition of city streets by improving deteriorating infrastructure.

Amount: \$760,000 City Engineer's Estimate

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2018-2019 CIP, Page Street – 5, Arterial Pavement Rehabilitation, ST267, G.O. Bonds to be issued

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the SW 9th Street Rehabilitation from Wall Avenue to Army Post Road, 06-2018-009. The improvement includes street rehabilitation by milling the existing roadway, resurfacing with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA), partial depth HMA patching, full depth Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement patching, pavement markings, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 596-238/259, located on SW 9th Street between Wall Avenue and Army Post Road, Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$760,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
