AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with Stanley Consultants, Inc. for additional data collection, design, bidding documents and permitting services for Easter Lake Watershed Improvements, not to exceed \$119,852.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the PSA with Stanley Consultants, Inc., Kate Harris, President & CEO, 225 Iowa Avenue, Muscatine, Iowa 52761, for an additional amount not to exceed \$119,852, based on hourly rates, to provide additional data collection, design, bidding documents and permitting services for Easter Lake Watershed Improvements.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On August 14, 2017, by Roll Call No. 17-1389, Stanley Consultants, Inc. was hired to provide Conceptual Design Services for the Easter Lake Watershed Improvements, including:
 - Conceptual design phase services for the improvements to the eight (8) detention basins as part of the Easter Lake Watershed Improvements.
 - o This Consultant Agreement includes the analysis and budget estimate for the best management practices that will best accomplish the plan goals for these basins.
- City staff has negotiated Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Agreement for Professional Services with Stanley Consultants, Inc. for an additional amount not to exceed \$119,852, based on hourly rates, to provide additional data collection, final design and bidding documents, and permitting services for the Easter Lake Watershed Improvements project.
