FISCAL IMPACT: NONE

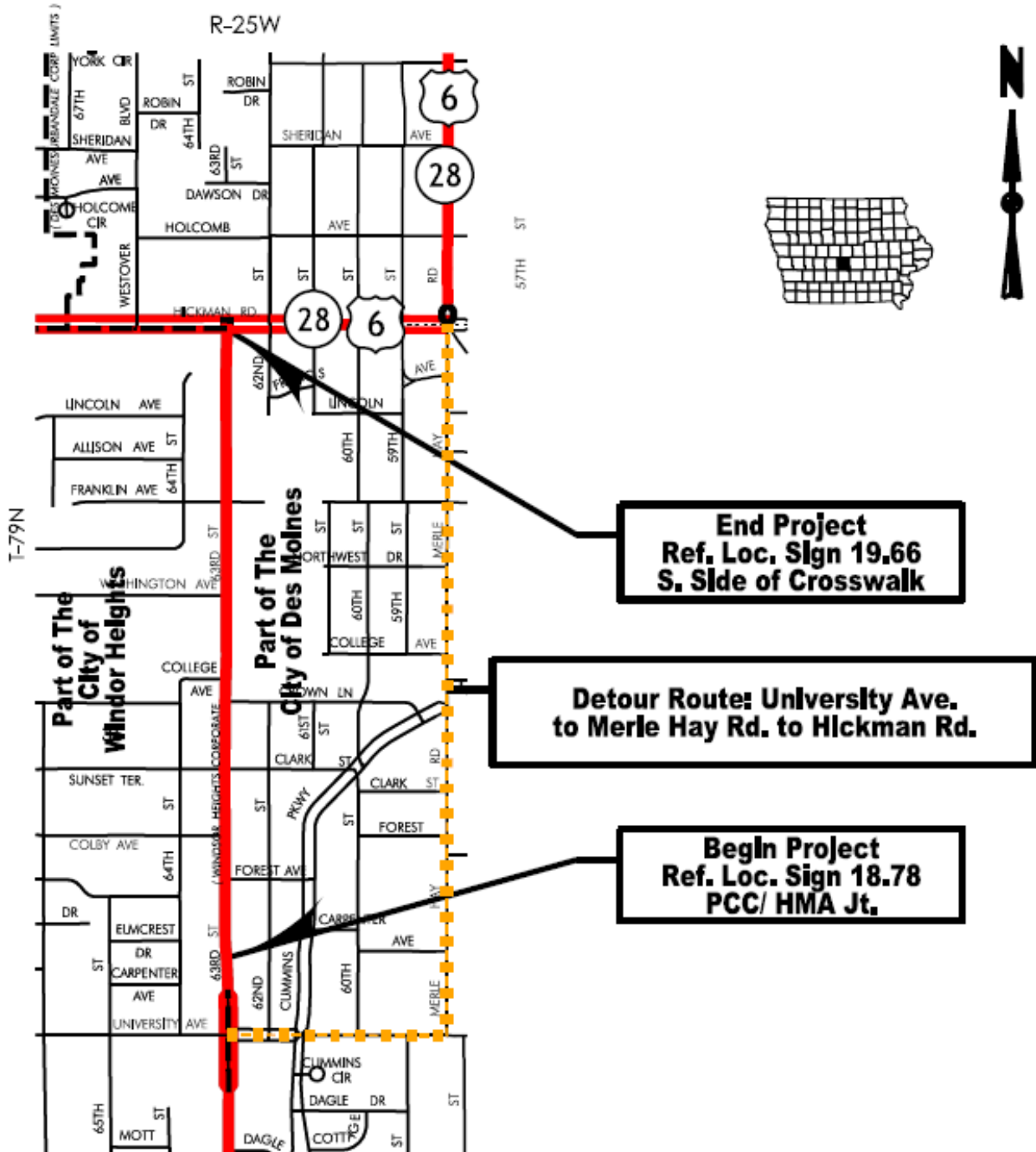
Amount: IDOT will maintain and provide all traffic control devices related to the detour and restore the local agency road to as good of condition as it was prior to the detour.
