AGENDA HEADING:

Approval to purchase three (3) Physio-Control LifePak 15 cardiac monitor-defibrillators for the Fire Department.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend purchasing three (3) Physio-Control LifePak 15 cardiac monitor-defibrillators, Physio-Control, Inc 11811 Willows Road NE, Redmond, Washington 98073.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$68,577.10

Funding Source: 2018-2019 Capital Improvement Project (CIP), Page Fire 4, Equipment Acquisition – Fire Department, being \$68,577.10 – G.O. Bonds.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Budget Review Committee recommended approval of \$70,000 for Advance Life Support equipment for the reserve ambulances. The purchase of the three (3) Lifepak 15 monitors will allow the Fire Department to equip three (3) reserve ambulances that will be deployable in situations where additional personnel are needed to provide coverage for the City during large scale events, special events where services are provided by the fire department, and special situations.
- The Lifepak 15 is a next generation cardiac monitor that provides ability to measure carbon monoxide and oxygen levels of a patient. The Lifepak 15 also provides field personnel improved diagnostic tools regarding diagnosis of cardiac events, such as heart attacks.
- With the purchase of the Lifepak 15 cardiac monitors, the Fire Department will trade-in two (2) Lifepak 12 cardiac monitors for a total of \$10,000. The Lifepak 12 cardiac monitors will be obsolete in January 2019.
