# **AGENDA HEADING:**

Hearing on SW 9th Street Rehabilitation from Wall Avenue to Army Post Road: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Kurt Rasmussen, President, \$738,062.

### SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the SW 9th Street Rehabilitation from Wall Avenue to Army Post Road and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project will improve the existing pavement condition of SW 9th Street between Wall Avenue and Army Post Road by rehabilitating and resurfacing the deteriorated pavement. The project addresses citizen concerns regarding the condition of city streets by improving deteriorating infrastructure.

### FISCAL IMPACT:

<u>Amount</u>: \$738,062 Construction Contract (\$760,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

On June 11, 2018, under Roll Call No. 18-0957, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the SW 9th Street Rehabilitation from Wall Avenue to Army Post Road. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the SW 9th Street Rehabilitation from Wall Avenue to Army Post Road, 06-2018-009. The improvement includes street rehabilitation by milling the existing roadway, resurfacing with Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA), partial depth HMA patching, full depth Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement patching, pavement markings, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 596-238/259, located on SW 9th Street between Wall Avenue and Army Post Road, Des Moines, Iowa.

- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Kurt Rasmussen, President, 5550 NE 22<sup>nd</sup> Street, Des Moines, IA, 50313 in the amount of \$738,062, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
