AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to the Agreement for Professional Services with Foth Infrastructure & Environment, LLC for additional professional services for the Hubbell Avenue Corridor Safety Improvements, not to exceed \$706,600.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to the Agreement for Professional Services with Foth Infrastructure & Environment, LLC, 8191 Birchwood Court, Suite L, Johnston, IA, 50131, for an additional amount not to exceed \$706,600, based on hourly rates, to provide construction phase services for the Hubbell Avenue Corridor Safety Improvements.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On July 13, 2015, by Roll Call No. 15-1123, City Council approved a Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with Foth Infrastructure & Environment, LLC for the Hubbell Avenue Corridor Safety Improvements, not to exceed \$175,000 for conceptual design services and a traffic study.
- On April 11, 2016, by Roll Call No. 16-0552, City Council approved the conceptual plan for the Hubbell Avenue Corridor Improvements.
- On July 25, 2016, by Roll Call No. 16-1186, City Council approved Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the PSA with Foth Infrastructure & Environment, LLC for the Hubbell Avenue Corridor Safety Improvements, not to exceed \$997,600 for the final design phase services.
- City staff have negotiated Supplemental Agreement No. 2 to the PSA with Foth Infrastructure & Environment, LLC for an additional amount not to exceed \$706,600, based on hourly rates, to provide construction phase services for the Hubbell Avenue Corridor Safety Improvements.

- On June 11, 2018, City Council ordered construction of the Hubbell Avenue Reconstruction from Euclid to east of E. 38th Street – receiving bids, (6-26-18), and Setting date of hearing, (7-9-18).
- Construction of the Hubbell Avenue Reconstruction project is scheduled to start late summer/early fall 2018 and be completed summer 2020.
