AGENDA HEADING:

Amending Chapter 114 of the Municipal Code regarding traffic regulation changes as follows:

- A. Changes to part-time one-way streets to match new school hours at Park Elementary, Findley Elementary, Morris Elementary, Madison Elementary, Cattell Elementary, Moulton Learning Center, and McKee Education Center.
- B. Removal of no parking anytime restriction on 19th Place from Cottage Grove to Olive Avenue.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of the staff recommendations and the ordinance regarding the traffic regulation changes.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Minor costs for sign installations.

Funding Source: 2018-19 Operating Budget, Page 84 Engineering Department Traffic and Transportation—Sign, Painting, Signal and Lighting, EG062080.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- A. Beginning in August 2018, Des Moines Public Schools will implement new bell times, or school hours, throughout the district. The new hours flip the current hours, so that elementary students begin the day a little earlier, while middle and high school students start a little later. Elementary schools will now have the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 2:25 p.m. The following revisions to the Municipal Code are needed to update the street signing for the part-time one-way streets to match these new school hours.

Sec. 114-1810.01. Geil Avenue.

Geil Avenue, from Southwest Fourteenth Street to Southwest Fifteenth Street, westbound, between ~~8~~7:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and between ~~3~~2:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.; school days.

Sec. 114-1811.1. Hoffman Avenue.

Hoffman Avenue, from East Eighth Street east for a distance of 100 feet, westbound, between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.; school days.

Sec. 114-1847. ~~Reserved.~~ Boulder Avenue.

Boulder Avenue, from Southwest Ninth Street to Southwest Seventh Street, eastbound, between 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m., school days.

Sec. 114-1898. Eighth Street.

Eighth Street, from College Avenue south for a distance of 200 feet, northbound, between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m., school days.

Sec. 114-1901.1. East Twelfth Street.

East Twelfth Street, from Tiffin Avenue south for a distance of 100 feet, northbound, between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.; school days.

Sec. 114-1910.1 East Thirty-ninth Street.

East Thirty-ninth Street, from Mattern Avenue to Easton Boulevard, northbound between 7:00a.m. and 4:00 p.m., school days.

Sec. 114-1912.1 Oxford Street.

Oxford Street, from Tiffin Avenue south for a distance of 100 feet, northbound, between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m., school days.

Sec. 114-1946.5. Southwest Seventh Street.

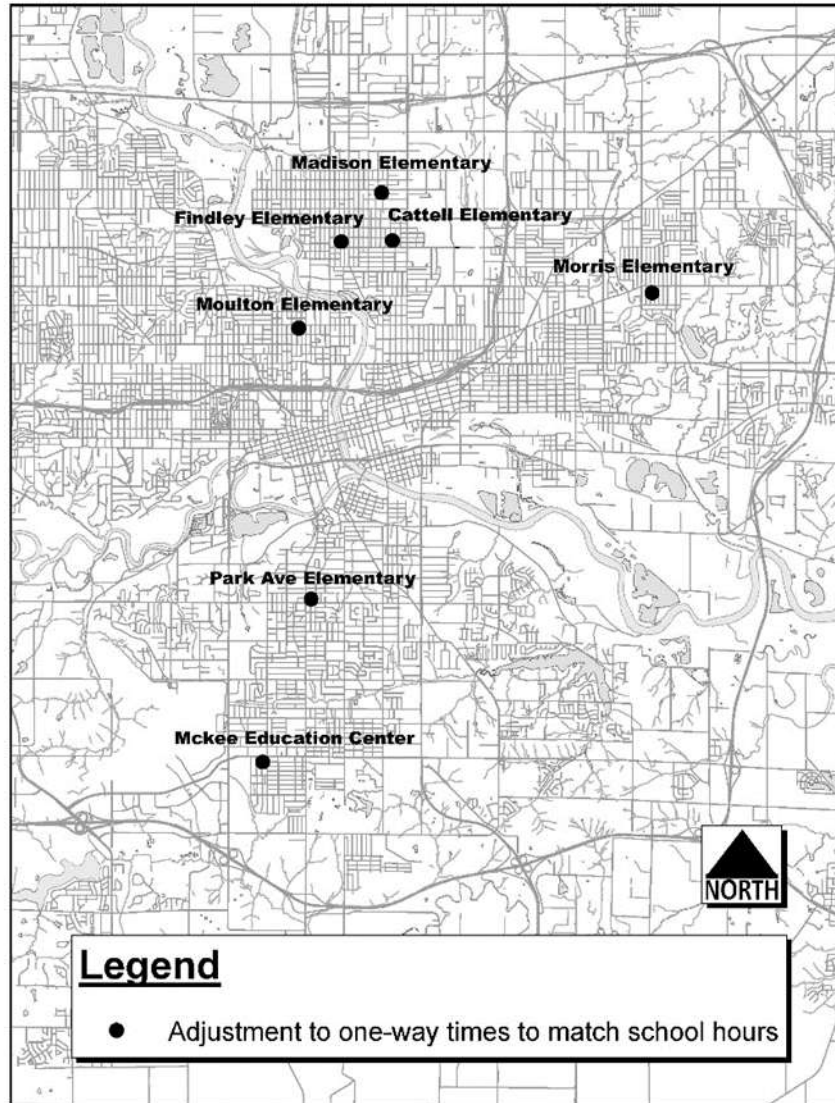
Southwest Seventh Street, from Boulder Avenue to Park Avenue, southbound, between 1:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m., school days.

Sec. 114-1949.01. Southwest Fifteenth Street.

Southwest Fifteenth Street, from Geil Avenue to Burnham Avenue, southbound, between 8:00 a.m. and 9:00 a.m. and between 3:00 p.m. and 4:00 p.m.; school days.

Sec. 114-1954.1 East Thirty-ninth Court.

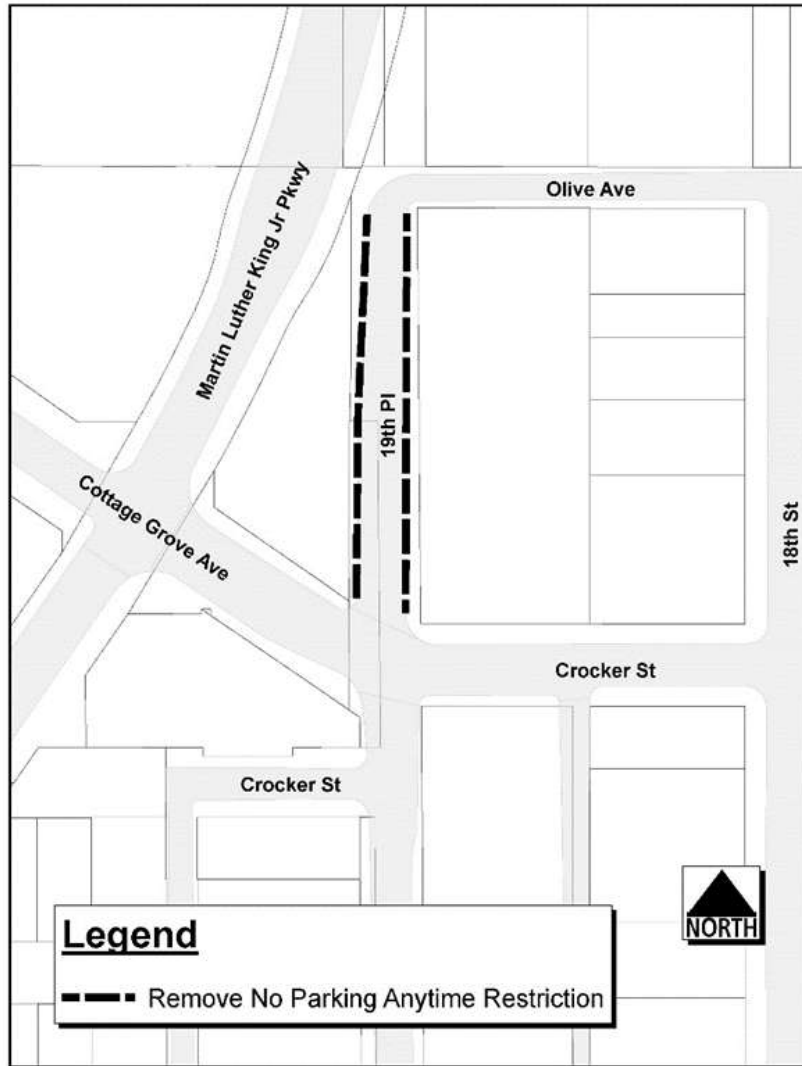
East Thirty-ninth Court, from Easton Boulevard to Mattern Avenue, southbound, between 7:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m., school days.



- B. A request was received to remove the parking restriction on both sides of 19th Place from Cottage Grove Avenue to Olive Avenue. According to the City’s parking restriction policy, the roadway is wide enough to accommodate parking on both sides. The follow revisions to the Municipal Code will remove the existing no parking anytime restriction.

Sec. 114-2787. Nineteenth Place--Center Street to dead end north of Olive Avenue.

Nineteenth Place, on both sides, from ~~Cottage Grove Avenue~~ Olive Avenue to a point 150 feet north ~~thereof of Olive Street~~, no parking any time.
