## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- The 42nd Street Streetscape project included removing existing utility poles and undergrounding overhead utilities to provide adequate space for sidewalks and improve aesthetics along the streetscape. MidAmerican Energy removed overhead utilities and relocated facilities underground along the project. The undergrounded facilities will be owned and maintained by MidAmerican Energy.
- This work was performed by MidAmerican Energy and was budgeted as part of the project costs. The original estimate from MidAmerican Energy for this relocation was \$337,234.
