ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

• At the City Council meeting on June 11, 2018, the Council approved the Fourth (2018) Year Action Plan of the 2015-2019 HUD Consolidated Plan consisting of CDBG, HOME, and ESG funding. From 2017 to 2018, funding for CDBG has increased by \$288,238, funding for HOME has increased by \$302,071, and funding for ESG increased by \$1,869. The Grant Agreements must be processed in order to receive the City's entitlement funding for these programs.
