AGENDA HEADING:

Accepting proposal for the provision of auction services for Fleet Services surplus vehicles and equipment and authorizing the City Manager to execute a contract for the provision of same with Housby Online Sales, LLC.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of an agreement for Fleet auction services with Housby Online Sales, LLC., an Iowa limited liability company, 4747 NE 14th Street, Des Moines, Iowa 50313, Kelly Housby, President.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: Three (3) year average annual revenue of \$240,000.

Funding Source: 2018-2019 Operating Budget, page 42, I201, Equipment Replacement

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- A Request for Proposals (RFP) was issued to procure the services of a qualified provider of
 auction services for the remarketing and sale of surplus vehicles and equipment for the Fleet
 Services Division. The intent in selecting a provider of auction services was to significantly
 reduce the administrative procedures and costs to the City of remarketing vehicles and
 equipment, and attain the highest possible net residual value of vehicles and equipment no
 longer utilized in the City's fleet. Three (3) respondents submitted proposals to the City for
 auction services.
- An evaluation committee recommended Housby Online Sales, LLC as the highest scoring proposer. Housby Online Sales, LLC provides turnkey auction services including pickup and storage of vehicles and equipment until a scheduled auction. Their staff provides title administration and payment collection and are experienced in selling all classes of vehicles, trucks and heavy equipment to local, national, and international buyers.
