AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Storm Drainage Category D Repair Contract 1 - Receiving bids, (10-9-18), and Setting date of hearing, (10-22-18). Construction Estimate - \$168,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for the repair of flood damaged storm sewers due to the flash flooding event on June 30, 2018, near 4126 Cornell Street, 3937 Bowdoin Street, and 615 Shawnee Avenue.

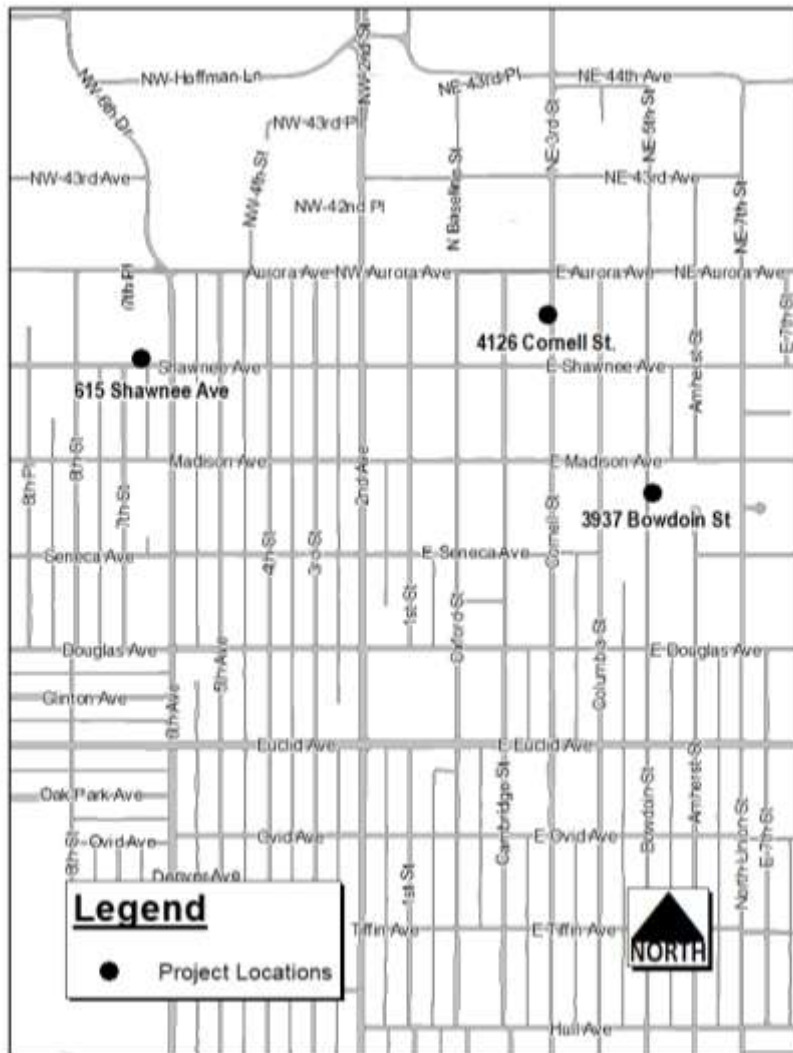
FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$168,000 City Engineer's Estimate

Funding Source: 2018-2019 Operating Budget, OP208, Being: \$142,800 anticipated FEMA Funding (85% of Construction Costs); and the remaining \$25,200 in Storm Water Utility Funds from City-wide Storm Water Utility Projects, SM057.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Storm Drainage Category D Repair Contract 1, 08-2019-005. The improvement includes installation of 24-inch and 96-inch Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP) storm sewer, manhole, Class 10 excavation, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalk, PCC curb and gutter, erosion control, ornamental fencing, restoration and other associated and incidental items; all in accordance with contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 598-117/121, located near 4126 Cornell Street, 3937 Bowdoin Street, and 615 Shawnee Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$168,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
