AGENDA HEADING:

Acceptance of the 2018 Edward Byrne Memorial, Justice Assistance Grant (JAG) award in the amount of \$184,378. This grant is a formula grant with performance dates of October 1, 2017 through September 30, 2021. No matching funds are required.

SYNOPSIS:

The Des Moines Police Department requests the acceptance of the 2018 Edward Byrne Memorial JAG award. The Police Department received Council authorization to submit an application and the acceptance of a Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) during the August 20, 2018 Council meeting.

The award has been granted in the amount of \$184,378 with the Des Moines Police Department being the financial agent. The City of Des Moines is allocated \$158,378 toward the purchase of law enforcement equipment to support policing and dispatch activities within the community.

In accordance with JAG’s recommended allocations, sub-grants will be made to the City of West Des Moines in the amount of \$15,500 to support an upgrade to the police facility security and the Polk County Sherriff in the amount of \$10,500 to support updates to patrol rifles.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The 2018 grant for Des Moines includes funding for the replacement of workstations and reconfiguration of Des Moines Dispatch Center. These changes in the dispatch center are being driven by new equipment required for the P-25 radio replacement project. Funding also includes the 25 rifles to expansion availability in marked patrol vehicles.

- The Des Moines Police Department submits an annual application for the Edward Byrne Memorial JAG. The funding is intended to assist law enforcement agencies with equipment needs that are beyond their annual budget.
- The application includes the City of Des Moines as the primary applicant and the fiscal manager with the City of West Des Moines and the Polk County Sheriff's Office as sub-grantees.
