# **AGENDA HEADING:**

Public Hearing for the proposed 1st Amendment to the Forest Avenue Urban Renewal Plan.

#### SYNOPSIS:

This roll call opens and closes the public hearing on the proposed 1st Amendment to the Forest Avenue Urban Renewal Plan. The proposed Amendment updates the Urban Renewal Plan by adding a new appendix: "Appendix D – Approved Economic and Redevelopment Activities." The Neighborhood Development Corporation Multi-Family Project had been described in the Plan text, but in a more general way. This amendment does not change the original project as described, but more clearly lists it in the Appendix. This Amendment also updates the financial condition report, "Appendix C – Financial Condition Report."

- The purpose of the Forest Avenue Urban Renewal Plan is to encourage the removal and redevelopment of the blighted, obsolete, and underutilized property within the urban renewal area for medium-density and/or high-density housing. The Plan consists of five (5) parcels and adjacent rights-of-way, encompassing 2.3-acres. There is one (1) project identified within the Plan: a multi-family residential project built by the Neighborhood Development Corporation. This Amendment more clearly describes the project in the Appendix.
