AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2019 Roadway Reconstruction Program - Receiving bids, (11-6-18), and Setting date of hearing, (11-19-18). Construction Estimate - \$3,150,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project will reconstruct deteriorated roadway pavement on S.E. 5th Street from E. Park Avenue to E. Broad Street and on South Union Street between E. Park Avenue and E. Kirkwood Avenue. This project also adds a sidewalk along the west side of S.E. 5th Street from E. Park Avenue to E. Broad Street.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$3,150,000 City Engineer's Estimate

Funding Source: 2018-2019 CI, Page Street – 32, Roadway Reconstruction, ST260, Being: \$1,868,337.40 Road Use Tax Funds, \$205,850 of Storm Water Utility Funds, \$90,805 in G.O. bonds transferred from ST269, and the remaining \$985,007.60 from Des Moines Water Works.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer’s estimate for the construction of the 2019 Roadway Reconstruction Program, 06-2019-003. The improvement includes roadway reconstruction with full-depth Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) pavement, modified subbase, subdrain, subgrade treatment, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) curb and gutter, PCC driveways, pavement removal, grading, PCC sidewalk, storm sewer, water main, traffic control, pavement markings, surface restoration, and other incidental items; all in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 599-001/143, located on S.E. 5th Street from E. Park Avenue to E. Broad Street, and South Union Street from E. Park Avenue to E. Kirkwood Avenue, Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$3,150,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
