AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on Storm Drainage Category D Repair Contract 2: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as TK Concrete, Inc., Tony J. Ver Meer, President, \$272,803.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Storm Drainage Category D Repair Contract 2 and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project will repair damage to storm sewer outlets due to flash flooding events on June 30, 2018 at three (3) locations: east of the intersection of Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway & Clarkson Avenue, 2501 Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, and 5011 Twana Drive.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$272,803 Construction Contract (\$366,000 City Engineer's Estimate)

<u>Funding Source</u>: 2018-2019 Operating Budget, OP208, Being: \$231,882.55 anticipated FEMA Funding (85% of Construction Costs); and the remaining \$40,920.45 in Storm Water Utility Funds from City-wide Storm Water Utility Projects, SM057

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

• On October 8, 2018, under Roll Call No. 18-1648, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Storm Drainage Category D Repair Contract 2. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Storm Drainage Category D Repair Contract 2, 08-2019-007. The improvement includes clearing and grubbing, Class 10 embankment, grading, 15" Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP) storm sewer, 36" RCP storm sewer, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) sidewalk, traffic control, seeding, and miscellaneous associated work including cleanup and restoration; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 598-124/131, located near Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway & Clarkson Avenue, 2501 Martin Luther King Jr. Parkway, and 5011 Twana Drive, Des Moines, Iowa.


