AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Change Order No. 4 with Minturn, Inc. for additional work on the 2018 Brick Sidewalk Repair and Improvements, in the amount of \$94,885.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Change Order No. 4 in an amount not to exceed \$94,885 with Minturn, Inc., Clint Rhoads, President, 144 W. Front Street, Brooklyn, Iowa, 52211, for additional work on the 2018 Brick Sidewalk Repair and Improvements.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$94,885

<u>Funding Source</u>: \$44,885 from 2018-2019 CIP, Page Street – 34, Sidewalk Replacement, SW084, G.O. Bonds, and the remaining \$50,000 to be reimbursed by Des Moines University.

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On March 19, 2018, under Roll Call No. 18-0513, the City Council approved plans and specifications and designated the lowest responsible bidder as Minturn, Inc. for \$396,419.80.
- Change Order Nos. 1, 2 and 3 added rehabilitation of brick in lieu of reconstruction, underground storage tank removal, and fence rehabilitation.
- The Ingersoll Avenue and Grand Avenue Traffic Study indicated the need for a mid-block pedestrian crossing on Grand Avenue between 31st Street and 35th Street. Des Moines University also requested the crossing because of the uncontrolled crossing of students and residents at this location due to the lengthy spacing between controlled crossings at 31st Street and 35th Street.
- To accommodate the mid-block pedestrian crossing at Des Moines University, the roadway will be symmetrically widened by three (3) feet on the north and south sides of Grand Avenue, a six (6) foot wide pedestrian refuge island will be installed in the middle of the roadway, as well as the installation of Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant sidewalks.

• Change Order No. 4 includes installation of the mid-block crossing on Grand Avenue at Des Moines University as part of the 2018 Brick Sidewalk Repair and Improvements.
