AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: Four Mile Community Center Window Replacement - Receiving bids, (12-18-18), and Setting date of hearing, (1-14-19). Construction Estimate - \$85,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project replaces the original 1972-vintage non-thermally-broken aluminum windows and storefront entrances with new energy-compliant aluminum windows and storefront assemblies.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Four Mile Community Center Window Replacement, 10-2019-005. The improvement includes the removal of the existing aluminum windows, exterior aluminum storefront entrances, removal and storage of existing window mini-blinds for reinstallation and the installation of new thermally broken aluminum framed windows with 1-inch insulating glass and aluminum storefront assemblies; all work in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 584-154/160, at the Four Mile Community Center, 3711 Easton Boulevard, Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$85,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
- Construction of this project is anticipated to start spring 2019 and be completed summer 2019.
