

## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Principal Park Cub Club Reroofing, 10-2019-002. The improvement includes the complete removal of the existing roofing materials and installation of a fully adhered white Thermoplastic Polyolefin (TPO) roof on the Cub Club; all work in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 600-289/291, located at Principal Park, One Line Drive, Des Moines, Iowa.
- The estimated construction cost is \$108,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of
  contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's
  Office.
