AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the Professional Services Agreement (PSA) with HR Green, Inc. for additional professional services for Yeader Creek Stabilization Improvements Phase 2, not to exceed \$109,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Approving Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the PSA with HR Green, Inc., James Rasmussen, President-Water, 5525 Merle Hay Road, Johnston, Iowa, 50131, for a total cost not to exceed \$109,000, based on hourly rates, to provide additional professional services for Yeader Creek Stabilization Improvements Phase 2.



ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The 2012 Easter Lake Water Quality Management Plan identified seven (7) project areas within Yeader Creek where improvements were recommended to reduce bed/bank erosion which is a major source of sediment loading affecting Easter Lake. Two (2) of the project locations (YC-8, along South Branch of Yeader Creek and YC-14, along Spring Street west of SW 9th Street) were constructed as part of Phase 1 of the Yeader Creek Stabilization Improvements.
- Phase 2 of the Yeader Creek Stabilization Improvements includes improvements for the remaining five (5) project areas:
 - o YC-9, Lower Main Branch SE 15th Street to 17th Street: Construction of grade control structures, rock chutes, and toe rock.
 - YC-10, Main Branch at East McKinley Avenue and Southeast 9th Street: Construction of grade control structures, toe rock, and outfall repairs.
 - o YC-11, Main Branch at Southeast 2nd Street to 5th Street: Construction of grade control structures and toe rock.

- YC-12, Main Branch near Southeast 1st Court and Southeast Porter Avenue: Construction of rock chutes and toe rock.
- o YC-13, Main Branch from Southwest 8th Street to South Union Street: Construction of grade control structures, toe rock, and outfall repairs.
- On August 14, 2017, by Roll Call No. 17-1390, City Council approved a PSA with HR Green, Inc., for design phase services for the Yeader Creek Stabilization Improvements Phase 2 project for an amount not to exceed \$317,900. The design phase services under this PSA included site investigations, hydrologic and hydraulic modeling and analysis, conceptual design, and preliminary design and final design for approximately 2,000 to 3,000 linear feet of stream corridor. The agreement also assumed completion of acquisition plats and legal descriptions for forty permanent easements.
- City staff and staff from the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (IDNR) recommend completing stabilization improvements to the remaining 6,000 linear feet of stream corridor. City staff have negotiated Supplemental Agreement No. 1 to the PSA for additional amount not to exceed \$109,000, to provide design phase services for an additional 6,000 linear feet of stream corridor and complete acquisition plats and legal descriptions for an additional 40 permanent easements.
