#### **AGENDA HEADING:**

Hearing on Little Four Mile Trunk Sanitary Sewer: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, and receive and file bids.

### **SYNOPSIS:**

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the Little Four Mile Trunk Sanitary Sewer and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. The project provides for the construction of an extension of the Little Four Mile Trunk Sanitary Sewer to serve development in northeast Des Moines.



## **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

On October 22, 2018, under Roll Call No. 18-1725, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the Little Four Mile Trunk Sanitary Sewer. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the Little Four Mile Trunk Sanitary Sewer, Activity No. 07-2018-003. The improvement includes construction of approximately 8,160 feet of open cut Poly Vinyl Chloride (PVC)/Ductile Iron/Truss pipe sanitary sewer, approximately 1,490 feet of trenchless sanitary sewer, manholes, Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) driveways, field fence removal and replacement, rip rap revetment, steel sheeting, Reinforced Concrete Pipe (RCP) culvert, traffic control, erosion control, surface restoration, and other incidental items; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 591-188/209, located along N.E. 56th Street from the Iowa Interstate Railroad right-of-way to north of N.E. 23rd Avenue, along the westerly side of U.S. Highway 65 from Little Four Mile Creek to E. Douglas Avenue, and along the westerly side of E. 56th Street from Douglas Avenue northerly approximately 1,300 feet, partially in unincorporated Polk County and partially in Des Moines, Iowa.

- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on December 4, 2018.
- On November 19, 2018, under Roll Call No. 18-1954, the City Council cancelled the hearing
  on the proposed Little Four Mile Trunk Sanitary Sewer connection fee ordinance, withdrew the
  proposed ordinance, and directed City staff to re-evaluate the ordinance in its current form and
  submit a revised ordinance to Council for consideration and reinitiate the process as legally
  required. Therefore, the designation of the lowest responsive, responsible bidder and award of
  contract is being delayed to allow time for the revised ordinance process.
