AGENDA HEADING:

Approving and authorizing the execution of the Iowa Department of Transportation (IDOT) Agreement for E. 29th Street Resurfacing, Easton Boulevard to E. Euclid Avenue.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of IDOT Agreement No. 1-18-STBG-SWAP-050 for Surface Transportation Block Grant (STBG) Program Federal-aid Swap funding for the E. 29th Street Resurfacing, Easton Boulevard to E. Euclid Avenue. This project consists of pavement repair and resurfacing on E. 29th Street from Easton Boulevard to E. Euclid Avenue.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$750,000

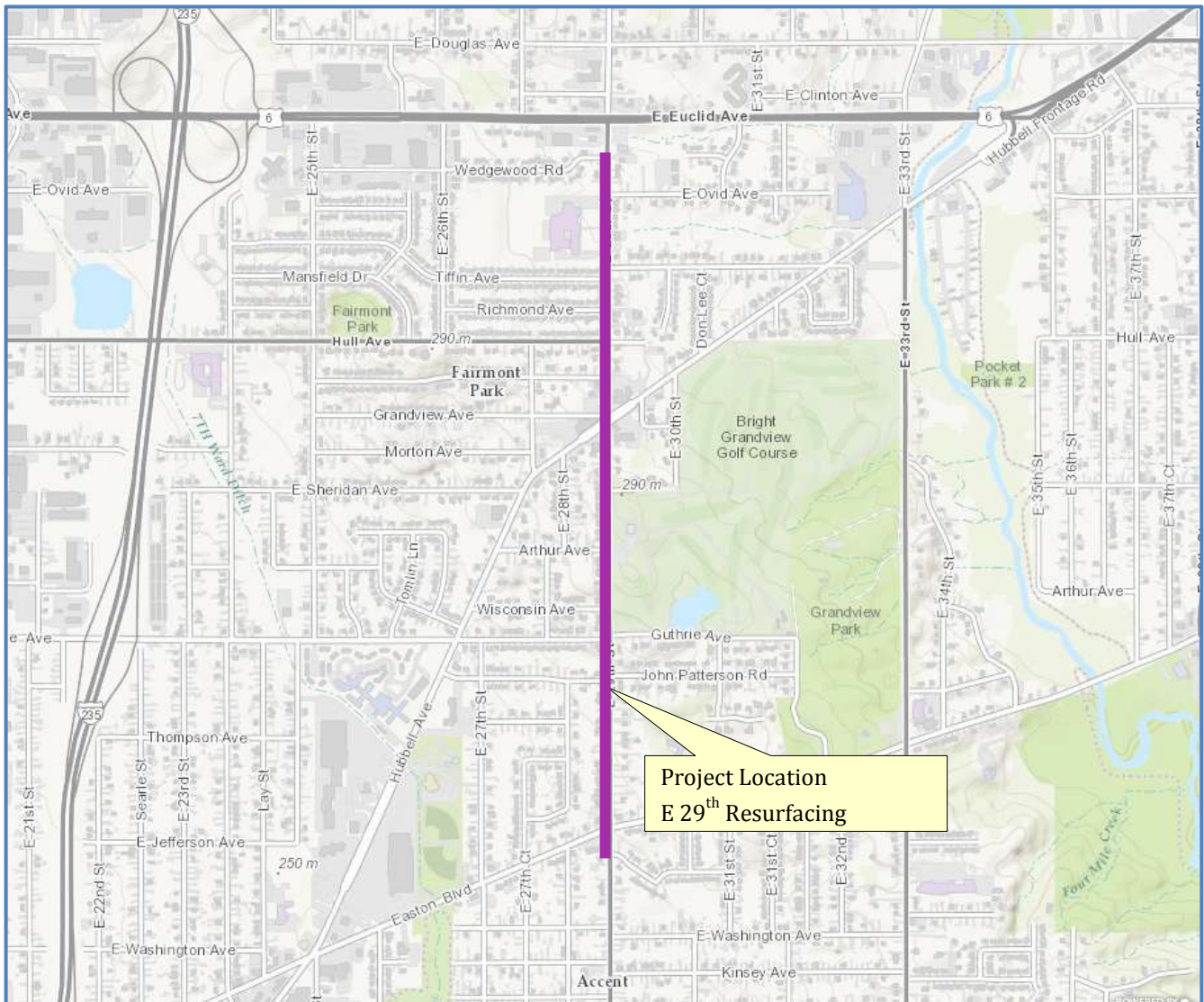
Funding Source: Various funding sources as follows:

- \$500,000 STBG Program Federal-aid Swap Funds
- \$250,000 2018-2019 CIP, Page Street Improvements - 30, Rehabilitation and Preservation of Major Roadways, ST222, G.O. Bonds to be issued

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The existing roadway is classified as a minor collector, 2-lane urban cross section and has an average traffic volume of 6,700 vehicles per day. This roadway also serves as a secondary north-south route into Polk County and the Iowa State Fairgrounds.
- The City was awarded \$500,000 in Surface Transportation Program funds as a result of the City's federal Fiscal Year (FY) 2019 application which was submitted in 2015. The Iowa Transportation Commission approved the Swap Policy, the allowance of local government entities to exchange federal-aid funds at its February 13, 2018 meeting. The Swap policy allows local governmental entities to exchange federal-aid funds, which typically have more administrative restrictions and requirements for state funds, which are less restrictive, for use on transportation projects. The STBG Program, formerly the Surface Transportation Program, is one (1) of the programs included as part of the federal-aid Swap for state funds; therefore, the E. 29th Street Resurfacing is considered a Swap project.

- Funding will provide for resurfacing of E. 29th Street Resurfacing from Easton Boulevard to E. Euclid Avenue. The project consists of milling/removal of the existing asphalt surface, patching isolated areas of failed pavement base, then overlaying with a new hot-mix asphalt surface. The total estimated cost of the resurfacing is \$750,000.
