AGENDA HEADING:

Ordering construction of the following: 2019 City-wide PCC Pavement Restoration Program - Receiving bids, (3-26-19), and Setting date of hearing, (4-22-19). Construction Estimate - \$204,000.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend the City Council proceed with construction of the improvement and set dates to receive bids and hold a public hearing, as required by Iowa Code, utilizing the method of financing referenced below. This project provides for timely maintenance of Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) residential and arterial streets utilizing full depth removal and replacement of distressed panels to improve the surface condition and extend the useful life of the streets. The contractor will work jointly with the Public Works Department for the PCC pavement replacement.

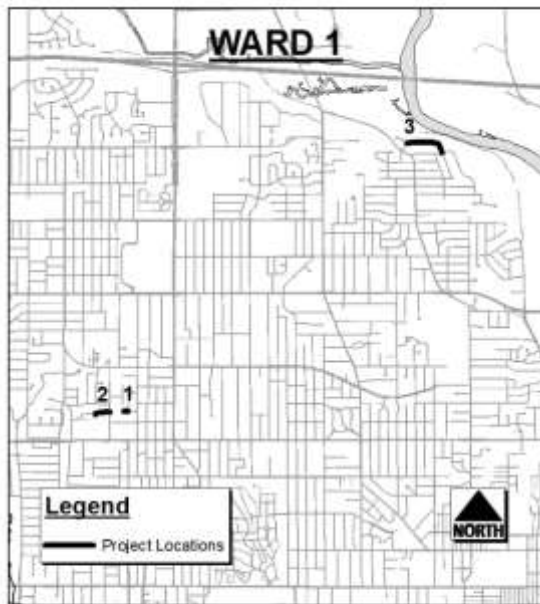

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- The Engineering Department has prepared plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2019 City-wide PCC Pavement Restoration Program, 06-2019-012. The improvement includes drilling, doweling, furnishing, placing, curing, sawing, and sealing of Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) pavement patches of various thicknesses in a cooperative effort with the City of Des Moines' Public Works Department, at the following locations in Des Moines, Iowa:
 - S.E. 1st Court from E. Kenyon Avenue to E. Porter Avenue
 - 11th Street from Laurel Street to Enos Avenue
 - S.W. 13th Street from Bundy Street to Burnham Avenue
 - 60th Street from Walnut Hill Drive to Grand Avenue
 - Dawson Drive from 63rd Street to dead end west
 - Holcomb Avenue from Westover Boulevard to Holcomb Circle
 - Philip Street from S.W. 5th Street to S.W. 7th Street
 - Philip Street from South Union Street to S.W. 2nd Street
 - School Street from 12th Street to dead end west

- Seneca Avenue from 48th Place to 48th Street
 - Skyline Drive from Hillcrest Drive to Oaklyn Drive
 - Truber Place from E Miller Avenue to Fleetwood Drive
- The estimated construction cost is \$204,000. The proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents are available for public inspection in the Des Moines City Engineer's Office.
