AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on County Line Road Culvert Replacement: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Peterson Contractors, Inc., Cordell Peterson, President, \$197,054.90.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the County Line Road Culvert Replacement and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project will replace an old timber culvert that has been identified as structurally deficient. County Line Road developed a sink hole due to the condition of the existing culvert and the road has been closed since October.

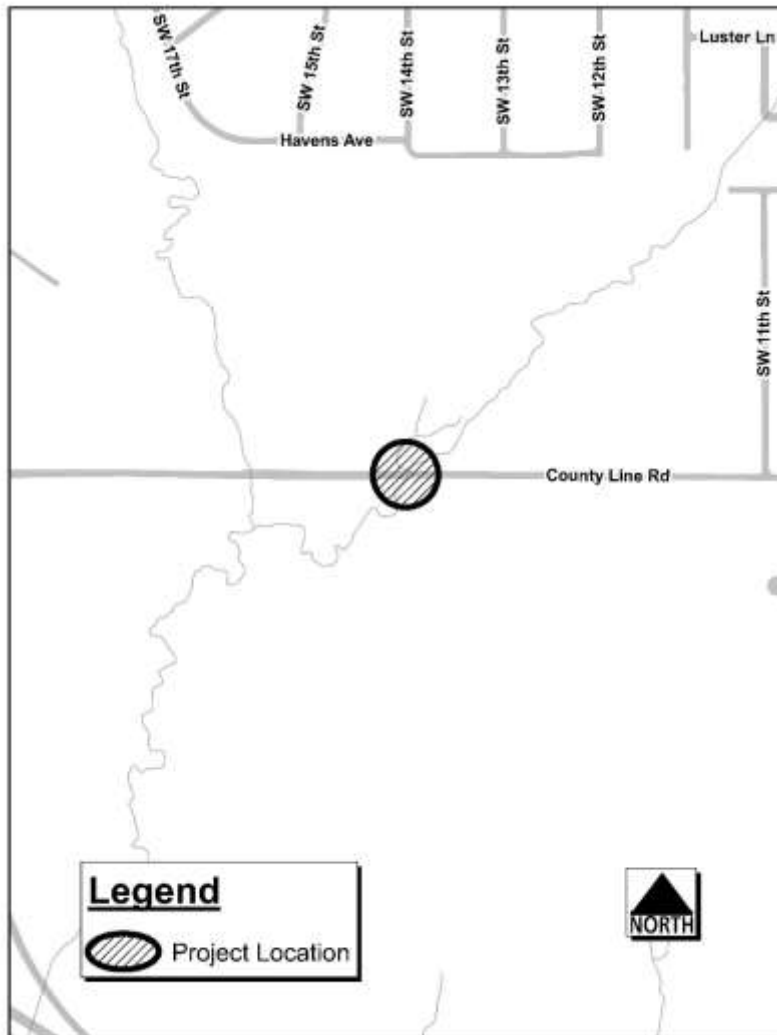

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On February 11, 2019, under Roll Call No. 19-0185, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the County Line Road Culvert Replacement. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the County Line Road Culvert Replacement, 08-2019-013. The improvement includes clearing and grubbing, timber culvert removal, pavement removal, Reinforced Concrete Box (RCB) culvert, Class A crushed stone surfacing, traffic control, seeding, and miscellaneous associated work including cleanup and restoration; in accordance with the contract documents, including Plan File Nos. 607-210/223, located on County Line Road between S.W. 9th Street and Fleur Drive, Des Moines, Iowa.

- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on February 26, 2019.
 - The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Peterson Contractors, Inc., Cordell Peterson, President, 104 Blackhawk Street, Reinbeck, IA, 50669 in the amount of \$197,054.90, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
