ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Kirk Bagby (NR-0) Lieutenant, to Boston, MA from June 1 – June 21, 2019 to attend the Senior Management Institute for Police (SMIP). SMIP is a program of the Police Executive Research Forum that provides senior police executives with intensive training in the latest management concepts and practices used in business and government.

T.M. Franklin Cownie (R-3) Mayor, to Boulder, CO from April 17 – April 19, 2019 to attend ICLEI USA in-person board meetings and general meetings, which allows for sharing of best practices and gaining greater understanding of sustainable practices to assist the City in its own growth.

Manisha Paudel (NR-0) Equity Coordinator, to Manila, Philippines from April 9 – April 14, 2019 to attend and lead a session for the Young Southeast Asian Leadership Initiative Program on program monitoring and assessment as a mentor/leader on sustainability. This will provide access to an abundance of educational information about how various countries in SE Asia as well as in the US implement strategies for successful program initiatives and its outcome evaluation and to allow the ability to apply that here locally.
