ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

Benjamin Campbell (NR-0) Senior Crime Scene Investigator, to Allentown, PA from August 11 – August 17, 2019 to attend the Advanced Bloodstain Pattern Analysis Course. This is an advanced-level training and is necessary in working toward becoming certified as a court recognized expert in bloodstain analysis.

Alyssa Powell (NR-0) Crime Scene Investigator, to Evanston, IL from October 13 – November 2, 2019 to attend the Crime Scene Technology I, II and III Courses. These courses will provide additional knowledge and training in crime scene documentation, processing, and evidence collection for crime scenes that are encountered on a daily basis.

T.M. Franklin Cownie (R-4) Mayor, to Washington, DC from May 8 – May 12, 2019 for a lobbying trip to speak with Congressional leaders and discuss the needs of the City.
