AGENDA HEADING:

Approving purchase of closed circuit sewer televising equipment from Elliot Equipment Company, 4000 SE Beisser Drive, Grimes, IA 50111, Gene Elliot, President.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval to purchase closed circuit sewer televising equipment for the Sewer Maintenance Division of the Department of Public Works to inspect and identify problem areas in sanitary and storm sewers throughout the City. The inspections are used to identify and schedule maintenance needs, investigate legal claims against the City and perform inspections for engineering projects. This equipment will replace older equipment that has reached the end of its serviceable life.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$64,140.65

Funding Source: 2019-2020 Operating Budget, page 103, Equipment Replacement Fund

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- This sewer televising equipment will replace equipment currently in use in one (1) of the Department of Public Works sewer televising trucks. The entire truck was due for replacement; however, staff have determined that the chassis and other televising hardware and software still have useful life remaining. This purchase will replace the sewer televising cameras and camera transporters.
- Elliot Equipment is the regional manufacturer's representative for RS Technical Services, which manufacture the sewer televising equipment. Only RS Technical Services sewer televising equipment is compatible with current Department of Public Works sewer televising trucks. Sewer televising cameras and equipment from other manufacturers is not interchangeable.
