AGENDA HEADING:

Hearing on 2019 Hot Mix Asphalt (HMA) Residential Paving Program: Resolution approving plans, specifications, form of contract documents, engineer's estimate, receive and file bids, and designating lowest responsible bidder as Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Kurt Rasmussen, President, \$1,089,369.25.

SYNOPSIS:

This is a public hearing to allow for public input on the 2019 HMA Residential Paving Program and take the necessary actions as required by Iowa Code to authorize a contract for construction of the proposed project. This project provides for the resurfacing of residential streets utilizing surface scarification and HMA to pave the surface to extend the useful service life of the streets. The project also includes constructing American with Disabilities Act (ADA) compliant sidewalk curb ramps as needed.

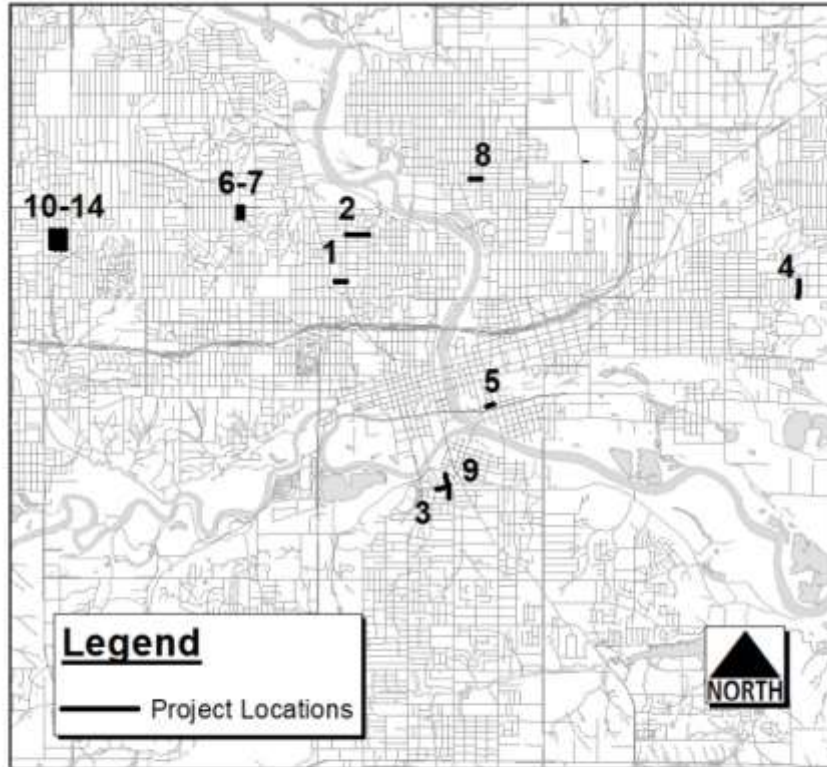

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On April 8, 2019, under Roll Call No. 19-0532, the City Council received and filed plans, specifications, form of contract documents, and City Engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2019 HMA Residential Paving Program. Before the City Council can enter into a contract, it must hold a public hearing and approve the proposed plans, specifications, and form of contract documents and engineer's estimate for the construction of the 2019 HMA Residential Paving Program, 06-2019-011. The improvements include furnishing labor, equipment, and materials all in accordance with the contract plans and documents, including Plan File Nos. 608-178/205, at the following locations all within the City of Des Moines.
- Removal of existing HMA pavement with milling/scarifying an average depth of 2-inches, replacing sections of Portland Cement Concrete (PCC) beam curb, and placing 2-inches of HMA pavement on Gillette Street from 16th Street to 18th Street.

- Removal of existing HMA pavement with milling/scarifying an average depth of 2-inches, with full depth removal along centerline as shown in the contract plans and documents, reconstructing HMA pavement with two (2) lifts along the centerline full depth removal, and single lifts within 2-inch average milled areas at Jefferson Avenue from 13th Street to 16th Street.
- Removal of existing HMA pavement with milling/scarifying to an average depth of 3-inches, preparing subgrade/subbase, and reconstructing 3-inches HMA pavement with two (2) lifts, and replacing existing sidewalk ramps with ADA-compliant ramps as directed by the engineer at the following locations:
 - E. 37th Court from E. University to Garfield Avenue
 - Raccoon Street from S.E. 5th Street to S.E. 6th Street
 - 32nd Street from Hickman Road to Lincoln Avenue
 - 33rd Street from Hickman Road to Lincoln Avenue
 - Morton Avenue from North Union Street to Bowdoin Street
 - S.W. 1st Street from Fulton Drive to Indianola Road
 - 59th Street from College Avenue to Franklin Avenue
 - 60th Street from College Avenue to Franklin Avenue
 - 61st Street from College Avenue to Franklin Avenue
 - 62nd Street from College Avenue to Franklin Avenue
 - Northwest Drive from Merle Hay Road to West of 62nd Street
 - Hillside Avenue from Courtland Avenue to S.W. 1st Street
- Sealed bids for said improvement were submitted by the following bidders:
 - Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Des Moines, IA
 - OMG Midwest, Inc. d/b/a Des Moines Asphalt & Paving, Ankeny, IA
 - InRoads, LLC, Des Moines, IA
- The bids were received and opened at a public meeting presided over by the Engineer in the City Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 400 Robert D. Ray Drive, Des Moines, Iowa at 11:00 a.m. on April 23, 2019.
- The City Engineer has determined that the lowest responsive, responsible bid for the construction of said improvement was submitted by Grimes Asphalt and Paving Corporation, Kurt Rasmussen, President, 5550 NE 22nd Street, Des Moines, IA, 50313 in the amount of \$1,089,369.25, and said bid should be accepted. The Finance Director has determined that funds are available for said improvement as stated above.
