AGENDA HEADING:

Approving Change Order No. 1 with Hawkeye Paving Corporation for additional work on the 6th Avenue Streetscape – College Avenue to Hickman Road, in the amount of \$69,712.91.

SYNOPSIS:

Recommend approval of Change Order No. 1 in an amount not to exceed \$69,712.91 with Hawkeye Paving Corporation, Anthony L. Perkins, President, 801 42nd Street South, Bettendorf, Iowa, 52722, to add electrical conduit and traffic signs to the project.

FISCAL IMPACT:

Amount: \$69,712.91

Funding Source: 2019-20 CIP, Page Street – 31, Sixth Avenue Streetscape, ST266, G.O. Bonds

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- On September 10, 2018, under Roll Call No. 18-1558, the City Council approved plans and specifications and designated the lowest responsible bidder as Hawkeye Paving Corporation for \$3,125,623.70. The project provides for the construction of streetscape enhancements, which includes the reduction of traffic lanes from five (5) to three (3), expansion of the pedestrian and biking access along 6th Avenue from College Avenue to Hickman Road. This project also includes green infrastructure components including biocells and permeable pavers.
- Change Order No. 1 includes the following additional work on the 6th Avenue Streetscape – College Avenue to Hickman Road.
 - Construction items to install electrical conduit along 6th Avenue for tree lighting as requested by the 6th Avenue Corridor Group. The 6th Avenue Corridor Group requested electrical outlets at each tree location after the project bid.
 - Construction items to remove and install traffic signs.
 - Construction items to make adjustments to intakes and manholes for storm sewer invert adjustments due to utility conflicts.
